- 1. To conduct my business in an ethical manner, so that it will reflect credit and confidence by the public in our industry as well as in my own business.*

- 3. To hold that the exchange of my goods and my fair service for a fair profit is legitimate and ethical, provided all parties in the exchange are benefited.*
- 4. To elevate the standards of my vocation by exercising a high degree of care in the execution of all work, and correct any defective work as a direct challenge to my ability and integrity.*
- 5. To protect and defend the public from fraudulent and unethical practices affecting our industry.*
- 6. To cooperate with the association in its effort to better conditions in the industry, so that the public, management, capital and labor will all mutually benefit.*
- 7. To operate my business in accordance with rules and regulations of constituted authority at all levels and in a manner which will leave no doubts as to my loyalty to my country and its ideals and fundamental principals.*
